

ROOTS of Boots

Ambros Kristen, was a Swede who lived in an immigrant community in northeastern Germany. At age 16, he entered the United States via SS Heidelberg through Galveston and settled in Shelby, just west of Bellville.

Feb. 1930: The Beginning

Ambros Kristen bought the bottling works and was involved in the operations until the mid 1940's.



Feb. 1945: Boots Kristen

Boots Kristen, son to Ambros returned from WW2 to farm and run the company.



As a new generation assumed control of the bottling works, Boots Kristen wanted to try something new. Boots crafted his own line of sodas called "Boots", and was able to produce them for a decade before the costs of replacing non-returned glass bottles forced him to stop.

Release of the first five Boots Beverages.
